


## **CONFIDIENTIAL REPORT**

"States he had a disease for the last five or six years to become a darvish (hermit). This disease increased very much during the last four months. Yesterday, the 22-6-1945 he decided not to continue to work. This **led** to his being put on a Military charge. I was sent for to take him into hospital.

Rie :- It is almost impossible to clear him of religious intoxication and hermitic life.

In the present state he is useless as a soldier. I therefore recommend that he be invalided from the service.

Att :- In view of his long service I do not find anythig but special strain and stress of the emergencies of the present war, as the attributing factor for his disease.




Recom : I, <u>He is an innocent accused</u> and recommended that the charge for which he is under open arrest may be washed and the guard withdrawn.
